Hope that everyone had a good Christmas. The rain before Christmas was on my list from Santa and many other folks lists too. It appears that most areas got between $\frac{1}{2}$ and $1 \frac{1}{2}$ inches. Hopefully everyone received some rain.

There was not a lot of change in water levels this month. Concho and Runnels counties water levels did not vary up or down over 1 ft in most areas. Eola area was an exception with a gain of around 4 ft.

Tom Green county had more water level changes than the rest of the district. South of 87 at Wall water levels tended to be 4 ft down from last month. North of 87 water levels tended to be up a ft or two except near irrigated wheat fields where it was down 2 to 4 ft. South of San Angelo and west of Susan Peak road water levels were about 2 ft above last month.

The new year is upon us and with it comes the yearly reports. Please try and mail in your rainfall calendars as soon as possible so we can mail back your report. If we have a well that we get water levels from on your property you will receive a yearly chart. The process takes some time so reports hopefully will go out some time in February.
