The rains and cool weather have been very nice. Hot weather I am sure is just around the corner. School is almost out please drive carefully. Cotton planting is progressing as fast as farmers can get in the fields. Wheat harvest has started.

For most of the district there was very little change up or down in water levels. One exception to this were areas where there had been heavy wheat or corn irrigation in the last 30 days. Those areas were from 1-10 feet lower. The other exception was a few places where the aquifer seems to have filled up and for those wells rises in water levels was 2-10 feet higher. These wells were just scattered around and showed a much larger rise from the last rains than from rains earlier in the year of near the same amount.

We will be doing our yearly water quality tests of wells in the district in July and August. Anyone wishing to have their water sampled and checked can call us anytime of the year. We can do water samples of underground wells in the district for free once a year.
