The rain has been nice but often paid for with hail, high winds and tornadoes. We are getting into prime watering season so please try and keep it on your land. Most everyone does a great job but it can get away quick.

Water levels from last month dropped in most areas around a foot and a half. In some spots with pumps running levels were seen 30 to 60 ft lower but they should equalize out when the pumps are shut off. Trees and pastures are growing so recharge is being limited by the water they take up even with the rainfall.

I am still trying to finish the pivot and drip maps. I have done approximately three fourths of the existing systems, but new systems keep going in. I am currently working on locating wells and watering systems in all 3 counties. With gas prices high we try and do as much as possible when in an area to hold down expenses.
