Water levels are still going down especially in the shallow house wells. Some of the irrigation areas showed a little improvement from pumps being off due to rainy weather but most improvement was just a foot or 2 higher. In many of the areas near irrigation we were still seeing drops in the water levels. Without a large rainfall event over most of the area water levels will continue to drop.

We are at that time of year when the biggest draw on the aquifers occurs. Trees are leafed out and taking up water daily. Houses and livestock are using more water now than at any other time of the year. Irrigation wells are at a peak output due to hot dry conditions and most of the farm acreage planted and needing water.

Pray for rain.
